

SATURDAY, JUNE 14, 2025

Shotgun: Teams will play their 4th and 5th 9-hole matches by shotgun starts at 8:30am and 11:00am. At approximately 3:00pm, the flight winners will begin a sudden death play-off to determine the overall champions.

Friday, June 13th & Saturday, June 14th, If for any reason a team misses tee time, they will join their opponents on the course and will forfeit a point for each hole played in their absence. Players 60 and over may play the gold tees. All other players will play the white tees.

### **HANDICAPS**

All guest handicap indexes will be verified with their home course. A minimum of 10 rounds must be recorded for a handicap to be accepted for this tournament. Any guest without a verified handicap index will be handicapped by our Golf & Greens Committee. The committee reserves the right to adjust a handicap at any time.

### **RULES**

USGA rules will govern play, such as the fourteen club limit. However, the one ball rule will not be in effect. Summer rules will apply, unless exceptions are determined by the golf professional, greens superintendent and tournament chairman. Unless conditions change, the ball will be played down through the green.

### **FLIGHTS**

Flights are determined as follows: teams are ranked from 1 through 60 by combined team index, then broken down into 10 flights of 6 teams.

### **INCOMPLETE FLIGHTS**

If a particular flight does not have a full allotment of six teams, the teams in the flight will play against par or a fill in team.

### **SCORING**

Points will be awarded for each match. The teams with the highest number of points in their flight at the end of the five matches will be the flight champions. Each match will involve the awarding of nine points to be computed as follows: one point for winning a hole, one half point for a tying hole, and zero points for a lost hole.

### **FORMAT**

All matches will be played at net better ball.

Net Better Ball Each player plays his own ball and the better score of the two counts. When handicapping these matches, the lowest handicapper will play to zero and the difference given to the other players



### TIES IN A FLIGHT

The order of breaking ties in a flight will be determined by:

- 1) Head to Head
- 2) Last match total points, then next to last match total points and so on.
- 3) A one hole sudden death playoff (same format as tournament).
- 4) A Merrill Lynch® style chip off.

### OVERALL CHAMPIONS (Shootout)

There will be a three hole sudden death play-off on holes #1, #8, #9.

Any handicap strokes given will be determined by the format as determined by the tournament proper.

If there are ties to advance on holes #1 & #8, the second ball will be counted. If still tied, a chip off will determine advances.

If there is a tie for the Overall Champion on hole # 9, the second ball will be counted. If still tied 50 foot putt on the putting green will determine the Champion.

If we determine the Champions, but if two teams tie for second, there will be a chip off.

### RAIN DELAY

Rain delays or cancellation of matches because of inclement weather are at the sole discretion of the committee. If matches are rained out, the committee will determine the options. If play is stopped, the sirens will be blown. Players should not stop play in the absence of the siren.

### **CONCESSION OF HOLE**

In an effort to expedite play, teams are encouraged to concede a hole where it is clear that the opposing team will win the hole.
